Work is continuing on the Enrichment Center and each week we get closer to this dream becoming a reality. The building exterior is finished and build-out of the interior will begin soon. While we're waiting on permits and inspections, we're continuing work on developing programs and fostering partnerships. We currently have plans for martial arts, drama, and visual arts classes for children 5-18, as well as life-skills classes, mentorship, and employment resources for children aging out of foster care.

Since 2014, we've provided essentials to children in foster care because every child deserves to feel valued. Our prayer is that the Enrichment Center will be a place for kids to realize their God-given value through dynamic experiences, access to opportunities, and interpersonal connections.
